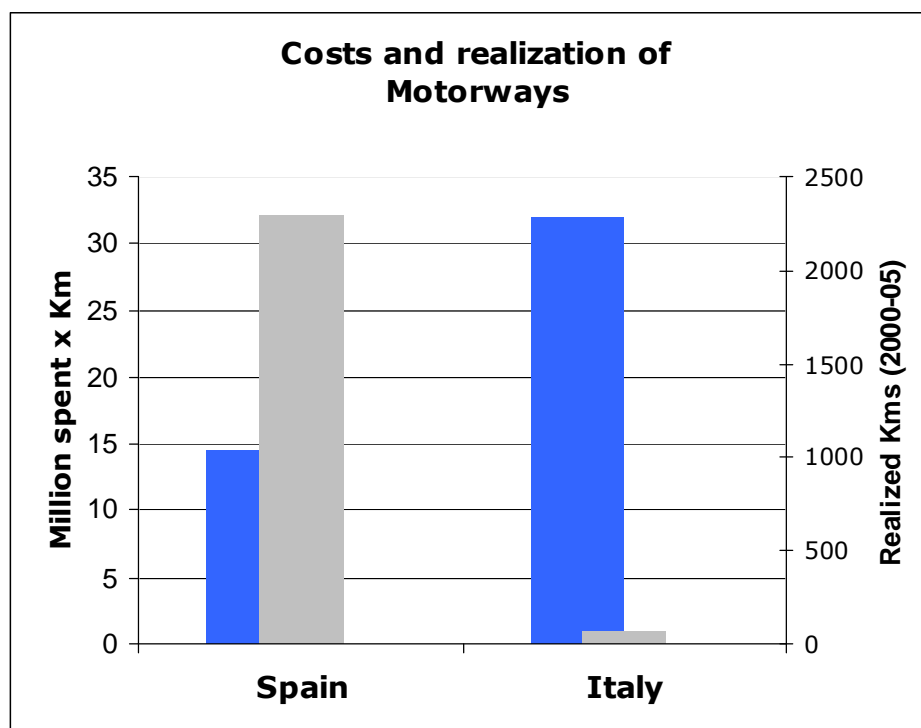
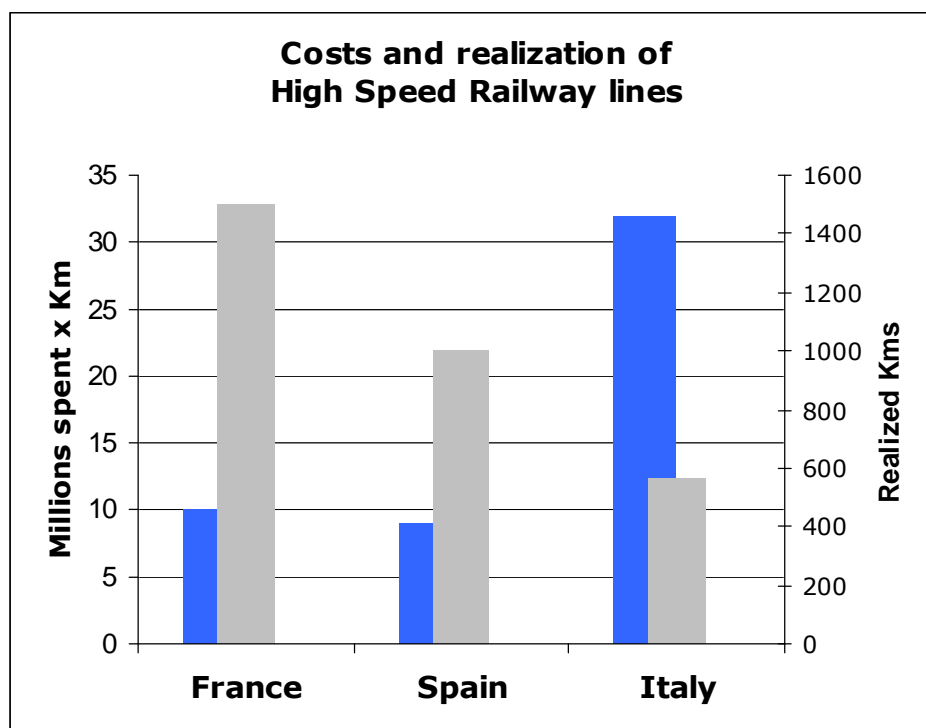

MAIN OBSTACLES

- **Fragmentation** and inflexibility in public decision-making chain (delay in realization)
- **Shortage** of public finance + **low** implementation of **PPP** schemes
- **Project management** methodology not adequately implemented (uncertainty in delivery time)
- **NIMBY** phenomena
- Low attention on **Healthy and Safety** issue



FEDERPROGETTI'S CONTRIBUTION TO ITALIAN INFRASTRUCTURAL GAP REDUCTION



- Increasing dialogue with Government to **reform** and simplify **decision-making process**
- Increasing dialogue with Italian Banking Association to promote active **cooperation on PPP** scheme
- Spreading the implementation of Project management (**training and certification**)
- Promoting dialogue between project promoters, public administration and local communities to **reduce NIMBY** effects
- Dissemination of international contractors' best practices in the field of **HEALTH & SAFETY** (versus LTI =0)
